Notice of Rights on the Revocation of Deferred Prosecution

- 1. You have received a revocation of a decision of deferred prosecution. The prosecutor has found you had violated the order for the deferred prosecution and has revoked the original decision of deferred prosecution.
- 2. You may file a petition for a reconsideration, specifying the reasons, to the case prosecutor for submitting to the chief prosecutor of the supervising prosecutors office, within ten days after receiving the revocation of deferred prosecution.
